The Student Leadership Subcommittee (SLS) was created to provide students with a stronger voice on the President's Advisory Committee on the Environment, Climate Change, and Sustainability (CECCS), enhance student collaboration, and drive student-led initiatives aligned with the broader CECCS mandate.

It consists of 12 students (7 CECCS members & 5 subcommittee-only members). Members span across the university's three campuses, representing diverse educational backgrounds but united by a shared passion for advancing student participation in sustainability initiatives.

CECCS was formed in 2017 with a mandate to advance coordination of the university's contributions and objectives on climate change and sustainability.
